She was leading the German delegation for Paris, with only 2 weeks to go. We met her at a **climate walk** near Wuppertal, Germany. **Secretary Hendricks** was pleasantly surprised about the news, and, she was so excited about this solution that she that she actually suggested to add a sentence about "worldwide cheap renewables" into Chancellor Merkel's speech for the Paris summit she was actually preparing.

We also sent the report to the White House, including a reference to the recent National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL) report, surveying ever falling costs for renewables in the US.
